The Tamang Society of America expresses its serious concern regarding the recent excessive use of force, suppression, and shootings carried out by the state during peaceful rallies and demonstrations organized by Nepal's **Gen-Z** youth. We strongly condemn these deplorable actions.

The violent crackdown on young people exercising their constitutional rights while demanding inclusive democracy, transparency, accountability, and good governance has caused us deep pain and outrage. This is a clear violation of democratic values and human rights.

The inhumane repression has already claimed the precious lives of many youths, while hundreds more have been injured and are now fighting for survival in hospitals. We extend our heartfelt condolences to the departed souls, express our deepest sympathies to the bereaved families, and wish for the speedy recovery of all those injured.

We firmly remind the Government of Nepal that protecting citizens' rights to peaceful expression is a fundamental duty of any democratic system. The use of state violence must end immediately, and those responsible must be subject to impartial investigation and legal action.

We also call upon the international community, human rights defenders, and all progressive and conscious members of Nepali civil society to take serious note of this incident, stand in solidarity with the victims, and raise their voices in the pursuit of justice.
